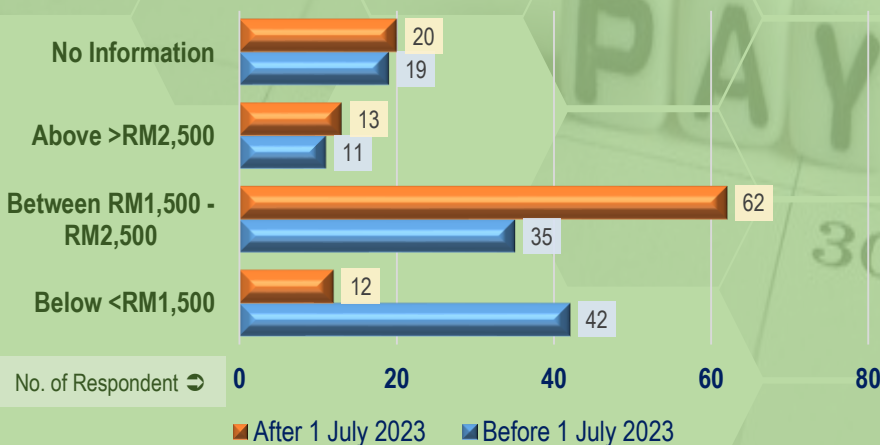

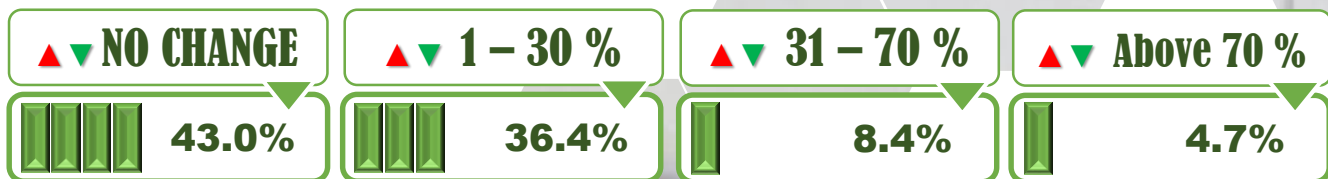
### Basic Salary Before and After Implementation of Minimum Wage Order



**Note:**

As of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023, the minimum rate of pay throughout Malaysia is as follow:  
 ♦ RM1,500 (per month)  
 ♦ RM57.69 (per day; 6 days working)  
 ♦ RM7.21 (per hour)
